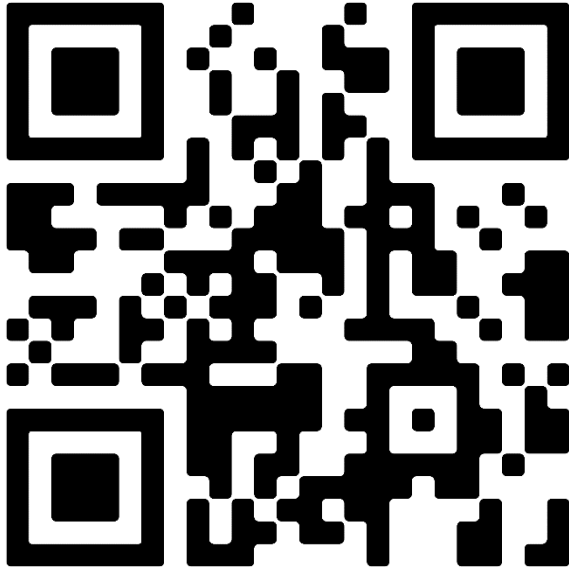
TRANSPORT (Courtesy bus)
